R-Controlled Vowels

When a vowel is followed by an **r**, it makes a special sound. The **r** makes the vowel change its name.

- -ir in bird
- -ur in purple
- -er in person
 - -or in fort
 - -ar in car

Every syllable has one vowel sound

- •Put a dot under each vowel
 - **aeiou** and sometimes **y**
- Underline any vowel teams:

ei oo aw

- Divide between
 - 2 consonants
 - 2 vowels
 - a consonant and a vowel
