

Visual Model Story Problem Puzzle


- 1. Cut out all of the cards.

- 3. Build the 3 different puzzles by finding the word problem, the equation, and the visual model that match.




There are 8 students reading books. Then 5 leave to go to the computer center. How many students are still reading books?
