Activity 1: Roll-A-Decimal

(Appropriate for AFTER the Broadcast Lesson)

Activity Goal: Order decimal numbers less than one

Targeted Math Skills: Comparing and Ordering Decimals

Materials: Paper, pencil, and dice.

Steps:

1. Draw a space to write 5 decimal numbers like this:

Targeted Math Skills: Compare and Order Decimals
