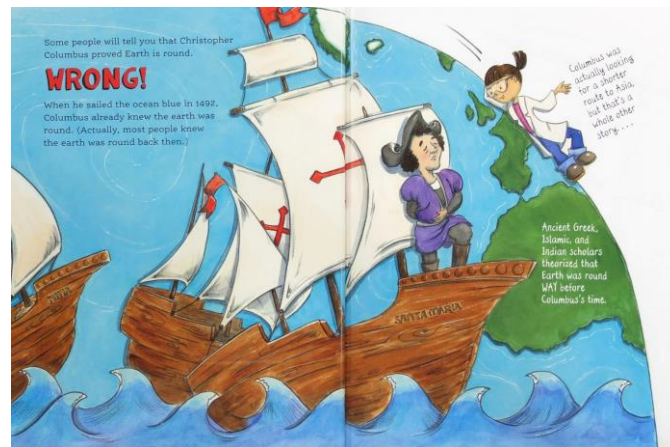

Text Features

In the book, *It's a Round, Round World* written and illustrated by Ellie Peterson, the author highlights information by using text features such as:

- big, bold, red letters to show emphasis
- illustrations that reinforce the concept that the earth is round
- different fonts (styles of letters) when the main character is talking
- parentheses for additional information.



Sort It

When we add **-ed** to a word, sometimes it represents the **/d/** sound as in **colored**. The suffix **-ed** can also represent the **/t/** sound as in **sketched**. Lastly, as in the word **painted**, **-ed** can be an added syllable representing the sound **/id/**. Read the words in the word box below. Listen to the sound that the **-ed** ending makes. Write each word under the correct ending sound.
