POINT OF VIEW WRITING

Choose an animal and write a narrative from that animal's first-person point of view. It could be a wild animal or even a pet.

- What animal will you choose?
- What facts might you need to gather? Where will you look?

TIP: First-person narrative writings use pronouns like I, me, my, we, and us, so be sure to use those words in your writing.

TIP: Remember in the third person point of view pronouns that could be used are he, him, his, himself, she, her, hers, herself, it, its, itself, they, them, their, theirs, and themselves.
